
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


2. Workshop on Developing Reading Habit and role of Library at School Level








3. Institutional Seminar on Khomokalin Asomiya Bhakhar Reh -rup

Sarma, Associate Professor & Head, Deptt. Of Economics, Tihu College, Tihu who deliberated on the topic – IPR - Prospects and Challenges. Dr. Subrata Barman, Associate Professor & head, Deptt. Of Economics, Nalbari College, Nalbari. who spoke on the topic IPR – Trademarks and Patent. The event began with an inaugural session where in Dr. Debendra kr. Bezbaruah, Principal, Kamrup College and Chairman-IQAC welcomed the virtual gathering and emphasized on the need for conducting seminar on such an important topic. The session had the auspicious presence of Dr. Dalimi Devi, Associate prof. & Head, M.N.C Balika Mahavidyalaya, Dr. Kishore Kr. Talukdar, Principal Tihu College, Dr. Padmaja Chetia, Mrs. Runu Saloi, Dr. Biswaji Das and Gautam Haloi of the Kamrup College. Inaugurator Dr. Debendra kr. Before starting the technical sessions students from the economics department presented their seminar papers on the topic. The Technical session-I on IPR by Mr. Dwipendra Kr. Sarma was extremely innovative. He elevated the topic to its crescendo by citing simple examples from day-to-day life eg- a combo Thali served in a restaurant and its patenting aspects. His take on IPR was so simple, crisp and precise that even a person from a non-Juridical background could understand and comprehend the same. There were various questions raised by participants especially research scholars perusing their doctoral studies on IPR and the resource person ensured their queries.

The Technical session-II on by Dr. Subrata Barman on Trademark and Designing also ensured that all aspects are covered both from an academic and entrepreneurial standpoint. He evaluated statements like 'Every brand is a trademark, but all trademarks are not brand' was very impressive, while citing examples of the Joha rice. Kola khar, assamese gamosa, etc". The technical session was followed by a closing remark by Dr. Padmaja Chetia who comprehended the discourses given by both the resource persons. Bezbaruah, Principal, Kamrup College. The dignitaries on the dias were Prof. Mukunda sarma, Principal, Bhawanipur Anchalik College, Dr. B. N Pathak, President of G.B, Kamrup College, and Mr. Chandra Mohan Patowary, Minister of Social welfare, Govt. of Assam. Resource Person Prof. Mukunda Sharma highlighted the importance on political, economic and security co-operation with countries in Southeast Asia through Look east policy. After the cold war, India wanted to act as a counterweight to China in Southeast Asia. He also focused on the look east policy tends to connect to ASEAN and the East Asian nations with an asianisation content. Resource Person Mr. Chandra Mohan Patowary explained the major differences between Look East Policy and Act East policy. According to him the major difference is Act East Policy not only focussed on developing political co-operation but also a cultural and strategic relationship between India and extended neighbourhood of Asia Pacific region. India has upgraded its relationship to a strategic level with many Asia Pacific countries. There is continuous engagement with these countries at regional, bilateral, and multilateral level. There is a greater impetus on people to people contacts, involvement in infrastructure projects of India and enhanced co-operation in Maritime security-related issues.
